The FEA Legacy Society

The Legacy Society comprises individuals who share a love of learning abroad, have a sense of wonder about the world, and are committed to ensuring the next generation of young Americans have equitable access to global experiences. By supporting FEA through your estate or life income gift, you are joining a special group of individuals who have recognized the timeless value and life-long impact of education abroad.



THANK YOU FOR CONSIDERING A GIFT TO FEA!

One-time gifts can be made to FEA to support scholarships and/or general operating expenses. Gifts above \$10,000 can be recognized through a scholarship named by the donor for a minimum of two scholarship cycles. *Recommended for one-time gifts up to \$75,000.*

Named scholarship pledges start at \$2,500/year for a minimum of three years.

Endowed Named Scholarships allow a named scholarship to be made in perpetuity each FEA Scholarships cycle. *Recommended for gifts over \$75,000.*

Estate Gifts provide support to FEA after the lifetime of the donor. They include bequests by will or living trust, future gifts of retirement plan assets, and life insurance proceeds.

- **Sample Language for Your Will:** *I give [__ percent of the residue of my estate], or [the sum of __ dollars] to the Fund for Education Abroad (FEA), EIN 26-3041520, in Washington, DC for its general purposes or for the benefit of [name of scholarship, program, and/or purpose].*

Life Income Gifts allow donors to make a gift now and receive income for their lifetimes. These gifts include charitable gift annuities, charitable remainder trusts, and pooled income fund gifts. Life income gifts also provide significant tax benefits.
