### Apply For A Study Abroad Scholarship

### TIMELINE

- \* Application opens: November 15, 2017
- \* Application closes: January 10, 2018
- \* Scholars announced: late March/early April



### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- \* Online application form
- \* Financial aid form (completed by financial aid office)
- \* Recommendation letter (from professor or advisor)



### FUNDING AMOUNTS

- \* Awards of up to \$10,000

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- \* U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- \* Currently enrolled as undergraduate at U.S. university or college
- \* Minimum of 4 weeks (28 days) in-country study
- \* Study abroad programs must take place in summer 2018, fall 2018, and/or spring 2019
- \* Program must be eligible for academic credit

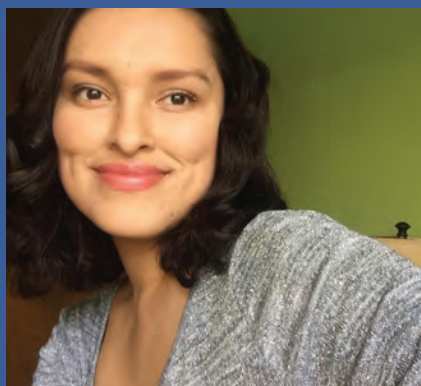

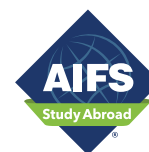
